Guy Fredericks' artworks possess a magic. Not a fluffy magic. Rather a weighty spark. His works hold the energy of quiet contemplation, as though having captured a moment of deep thought.

Working mainly in painting, pastel, animation and paper sculpture, Guy makes art about what he is passionate about: animals, plants, sustainability and the natural world. "I like painting and drawing animals," explains Guy. "When making animal sculptures I like to use armature wire for the frame and then form the shape of the animal using the papier mache technique."

Guy's early practice was inspired by botanical art and he has carried that meticulous attention to detail through to his other subjects. Whether it is a paper daisy, an animal portrait or a futuristic landscape marred by climate change, all are rendered with consideration and care. His more recent works see him move away from the preciseness of botanical drawing, focusing rather on personal connections and experiences.

Guy has worked out of Studio A since 2017 and has exhibited widely in that time, at Peacock Gallery, Auburn, Sub Base Platypus, North Sydney and Sydney Contemporary. He has also produced commissions for Liberty Speciality Markets, Art Month, Brand X and props for film director Thomas Avery. In 2020 he was shortlisted for the Liberty Speciality Markets Art Awards and engaged in a collaboration with Red Room Poetry.
