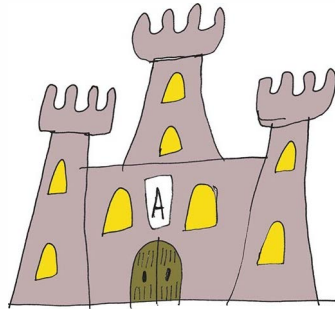

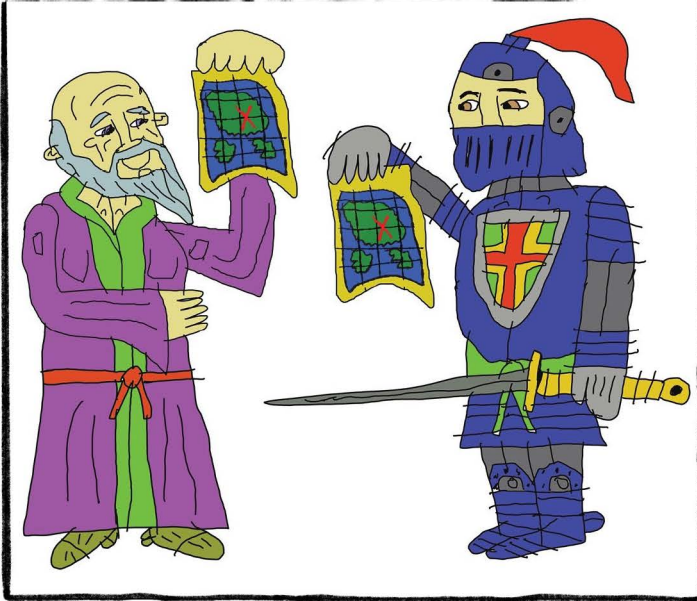

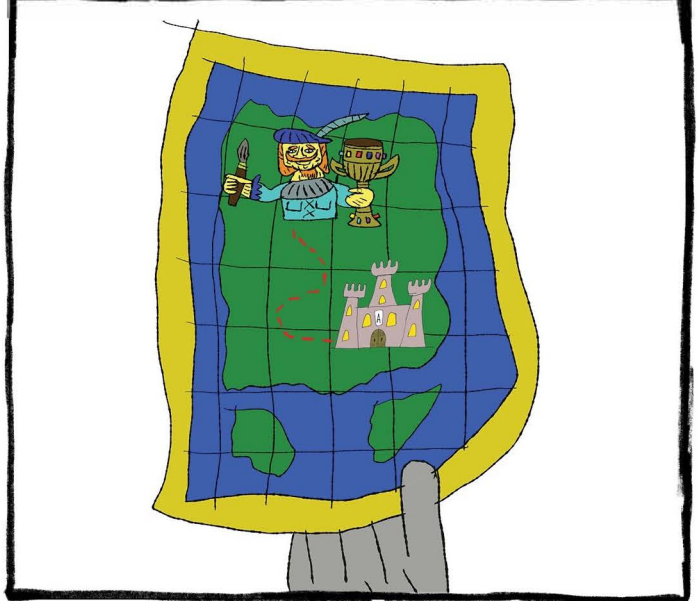
Studio A supports professional artists to help their creative dreams come true.

...what you wear,



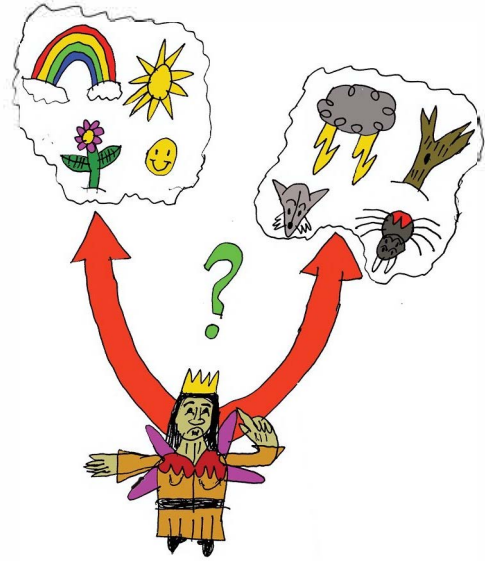
...what colour paint you use.



It's Studio A's job to defend your choices.



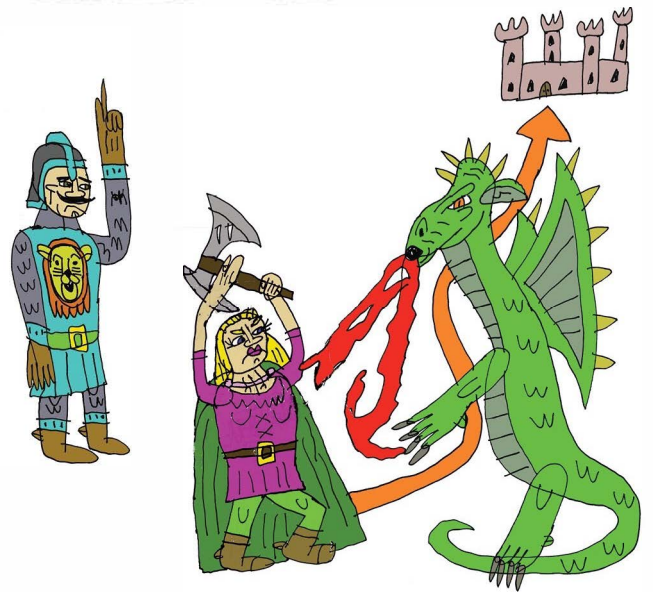
Even if that choice involves doing something risky or scary.



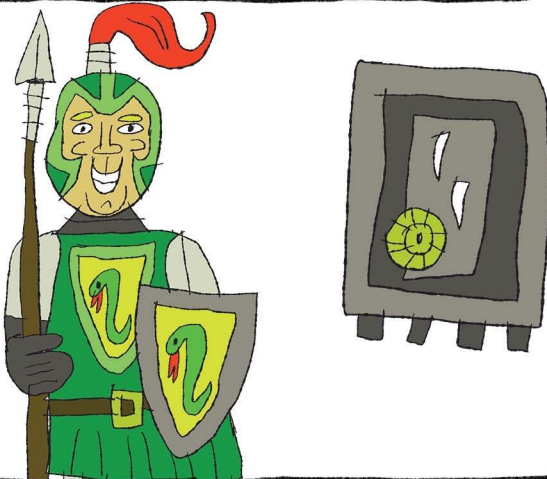
Studio A will help you understand any dangers or risks you might face.

All different kinds of people are welcome at Studio A,



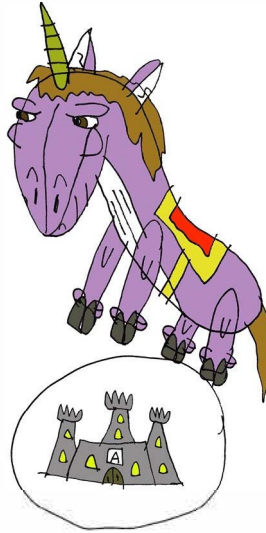
But Studio A is only for talented, hard working and professional artists.
